



## BC High School External Sport Credits

### Who is eligible to receive credit under the program?

The External Sport Credit program began in 1997 and is designed to recognize the level of participation which you are involved in as an elite level athlete in British Columbia.

External credits are available for swimmers registered with BCSSA and who have met the following criteria:

- Current BCSSA member in good standing
- Achieves a Provincial Qualifying Time in Finals at a BCSSA Provincial Championship.
- Is entering into grade 10, 11 or 12 the fall semester following a BCSSA Provincial Championship.

If a swimmer meets the above criteria they are eligible to receive "**Athlete 10**".

**Letters will be drafted each year after the Provincial Championships and will be given to the Regional Director at the Fall Provincial Board of Directors meeting, who will take them back to the region for distribution. The board meeting takes place in October so please do not email the Provincial Office requesting letters right after Provincials.**

Once the individual receives the letter they can take it to their school counsellor and they can provide you with the credit. Athletes can only claim these credits once.
