LOCATION:

- Penticton Community Centre, 325 Power Street, Penticton, BC

FACILITY:

- 25 meter, indoor, 10-lane pool.

ENTRIES: ENTRY DEADLINE: Tuesday, July 2nd @ 8:00 PM

- With entries, please include a validation list and best times - by swimmer name.
- Entrants may swim a maximum of **4 individual events and 2 relays**.
- Submit all registrations via Active with confirmation file by email to: pikes.pres@gmail.com **NO LATER THAN Tuesday July 2nd, 2024, at 8:00pm.**
- There will be no late entries accepted. Coaches will be provided with a confirmation list on the Friday before the meet. Invoices will be sent with that confirmation list. Payment in full will be expected on Saturday morning at the scratch meeting to the Meet Manager.
- **There will be no deck entries at this meet.**

ENTRY FEES:

- Each swimmer entered will be charged a flat fee of \$30. No refunds for scratches. No Late entries.

FOOD:

- Swimmers may bring food on deck and into the gym during the meet.
- There will be no concession available this year.

CLUB TENTS:

- We do not have any onsite space available for club tents but there will be space available to clubs inside the gym.

RULES:

All 2024 BCSSA rules apply.

TIMING:

- Colorado Timing System will be used with cardless marshalling.

FORMAT:

- **Heats and finals- 8 lanes**
- **Maximum 4 individual events and 2 relays**
- HEATS: seeded in the “Multi-Division/Open” format.
- Entries with no time “NT” will be seeded in the slower heats.
- FINALS: after lunch each day. Top 16 swimmers by division. Consolation finals only if there are 3 or more qualifiers.
- Div. 8 events will be swum in the morning as Timed Finals.
- Relays will be swum **after finals** each day, single gender, by division, as Timed Finals.
- Equalizer Relay: can be mixed gender and division. More info below.
- The meet manager may combine heats or finals at his/her discretion.

TURTLES:

- All Turtles must be registered with their home club and BCSSA.
- No charge for swimmers who only swim in Turtle (25m) events.
- The regular entry fee will apply for Turtles entered in any Div. 1 events.
- Turtle events will be swum in the morning as Timed Finals.
- A senior swimmer or coach may accompany Turtle swimmers.
- Turtles will receive goody bags.

AWARDS:

- Aggregate medals will be awarded for top 3 girls and boys for Divisions 1 – 7, O-cat 1, O-cat 2, and O-cat 8.
- Individual ribbons will be awarded for the top 8 finishers in Div. 1 – 4.
- Individual ribbons will be awarded for the top 3 finishers in Div. 5 – 7, O-cat 1, O-cat 2, and O-cat 8.
- Relay ribbons will be awarded for top 8 teams in Div. 1 – 7.
- Best time draws will be made.
- Most Sportsman-Like Team trophy awarded after Sunday finals.
- Points will be awarded for individual events to the top 8 swimmers as follows:
 - 11-9-8-7-6-5-4-3
- Points will be awarded for relays to the top 8 teams as follows:
 - 22-18-16-14-12-10-8-6

MARSHALLING:

We will be using the “Simplified Marshalling Procedure.” Divisions 5-8 will NOT be marshalled. These swimmers are responsible for being behind the blocks and ready to swim when the referee calls the race. There will be no check-in, marshalling, or announcing of events. The heat sheets will be posted to allow swimmers to verify their event, heat and lane assignments. Swimmers may still come through the marshalling room to congregate and organize themselves prior to going out on deck. Swimmers will check in with the lane timers to ensure they are in the right heat.

Marshalling for Divisions 1-4:

- Calling of the meet will follow the BCSSA policy regarding marshalling calls.
- Events will be called 2 times with 2 minutes between each announcement.
- Div. 1-4 must go to marshaling for each event. **For all div 4 events except for the 50 fly, the div 4 swimmer will be alone in marshalling. They can take this opportunity to see how div 5-8 marshal themselves, and will have guidance**

TIMERS & OFFICIALS:

As for all swim meets, all clubs are expected to have individuals to work as deck officials and timers. Clubs will be assigned lanes for timing based on swimmer numbers. Please organize volunteers from your club to fill these positions.

THE EQUALIZER RELAY:

The "Equalizer Relay" is run as the last event on Saturday. Each club will select 4 swimmers to complete (one relay team per club). Coaches select swimmers for this event and may use this event as a chance to reward their swimmers for sportsmanship, achievement or personal bests.

Swimmers selected must have swum the 50m free on Saturday (heats or finals) and not been disqualified.

The times for the swimmers are summed and the start is staggered, with the slowest entry times going first. Each team will be given a start signal based on their summed entry time.

For example,	Team A	total time	2:00
	Team B	total time	2:20
	Team C	total time	1:50

Team B will be started by the starter (the slowest time).

Team A will be delayed 20 seconds.

Team C will be delayed by 30 seconds.

The timers will have stop watches that start on the clock.

The timers will tap swimmer on the ankle when it is their time to start.
