The Greater Trail Stingrays Swim Club is accepting applications for a head coach and assistant coach or two coaches to share head coach for the 2024/2025 Winter Maintenance program. We are looking for an energetic, fun, motivated and organized applicant that can engage the full spectrum of swimmers who range from ages 5 and above.

The Winter Maintenance program starts in October and runs until Mid April 2025. The program is designed to maintain fitness and to continue to build the competitive skills needed for racing. Swimmers are allowed a maximum of 2 coached hours per week to maintain their summer swimmer status. Coaches will have a total of 4 hours of coaching time per week between Senior and Junior groups.

Head Coach Duties:

- Prepare and implement fitness training goals for each swim group
- Foster a fun, energetic environment while developing swimmers' technical skills.
- Mentor and further develop Jr. Coaches volunteering with the Stingrays
- Communicate and be available to answer questions from swimmers, parents, and Executive members at appropriate times

Head Coach Qualifications:

- Passion for swimming and working with children
- Competitive swimming experience with a strong background in swimming technique and training
- Competitive swim coaching experience
- Organizational, leadership, supervisory and effective communication skills
- Ability to plan and implement practice plans that are specific to the assigned group or ability level
- Completed The Fundamentals Coach (level 1) program through Coaching Association of Canada's (CAC) NCCP
- Completion of a criminal record check.
