ELIGIBILITY:

- Any registered BCSSA swimmer.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

- 25m, 6 lane indoor pool, starting blocks, lane ropes.
- Colorado electronic timing system with digital manual backup watch.
- The "Working Deck" includes the bulkhead and 1 meter on the sides of the pool unless further defined by the Meet Referee or Meet Manager.

MEET ENTRIES:

- Please e-mail the Hy-Tek meet entry file and Hy-Tek Meet Entry Report to **neptureg@telus.net**
- Entries must be received by e-mail no later than 7:00 PM Wednesday, June 26, 2024. The entry fee for entries received by this time and date is \$10.00 per swimmer. This entitles each swimmer to enter 4 events plus 2 relays.
- Relay teams will only be accepted in the Hy-Tek format. BCSSA Official Relay Entry Forms with the swimmers names must be filed with the Clerk of the Course before

9:30 am on the day of the relay. Forms will be available from the Clerk of the Course.

- Best times should be submitted, but only times the swimmer has actually achieved in competition. If no times available submit as 'no time' (NT). Heats will be seeded according to times submitted
- No switching of events once a swimmer is entered.
- Seeding is done by the Hy-Tek MM and a minimum of changes to seeding will be done at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course only to make the meet more efficient.
- Cat O swimmers will be seeded with S cat swimmers based on times where space permits.
- O swimmers may be used on a relay team as per BCSSA Rules

LATE ENTRY FEES AND SCRATCHES:

- No scratch meeting is scheduled. All scratches must be e-mailed ASAP or by noon on Friday, June 28, 2024. No refunds for scratches.
- Late entries received after 7:00 pm Wednesday, June 26, up to 12:00 pm Friday, June 28, will be \$20.00/swimmer. Clubs to use the KO Region scratch sheet attached
- Late entries received after 12:00 pm Friday, June 28 up to 8:30 am Saturday June 29 will be \$40.00/swimmer. The swimmers will be entered with no time and placed in an available heat (decision made by meet manager or meet referee)
- Late entries will not be accepted after 8:30 AM Saturday morning
- All entry fees must be paid to the meet manager by the end of meet Saturday. Please make cheques payable to the Nelson Neptune Swim Club. All unpaid entries will be billed to the invited club.

OFFICIALS MEETING:

- 7:45 AM Saturday & Sunday in the marshalling area. All Stroke & Turn and Senior Officials must be present.
- Timers and Place Judge meeting will take place at 8:45 AM Saturday & Sunday by the starting blocks.

Deck Officials:

- Sign-up sheets will be located at the announcing table for Timers. All clubs are expected to help.

COACHES MEETING:

- 8:30-8:40 AM Saturday & Sunday in marshalling area

MARSHALLING

Marshalling for Divs 5-8:

- We will be using the “Simplified Marshalling procedure”. Divisions 5-8 will NOT be marshalled, but swimmers must check in once at Marshalling at the start of the day. These swimmers are responsible for being behind the blocks and ready to swim when the referee calls the race. There will be no announcing of events for Divs 5-8. The Heat Sheets will be posted to allow swimmers to verify their event, heat and lane assignments. Swimmers may come through the Marshalling area to congregate and organize themselves prior to going out on deck. Swimmers will check in with the lane timers to ensure they are in the right heat.

Marshalling for Divs 1-4:

- Calling of the meet will follow the BCSSA policy regarding marshalling calls. Events will be called by Clerk of the Course staff 2 times with 2 minutes between each announcement. Calls will not be amplified and will be within earshot of the Clerk of the Course desk. Divs 1-4 must go to Marshalling for each event.

NOVICE EVENTS:

- Div.1 – Novice (combined) 25 metre races will be held on Saturday and Sunday.
- 25 m free: after 100 Fly – Saturday
- 25 m fly: after lunch - Saturday
- 25 m back: after 100 Free – Sunday

- 25 m breast: after lunch - Sunday
- Div 1 swimmers who are not ready to swim a particular stroke in Div 1 may swim that event as a Novice, but not the same event as both a Novice and Div 1 swimmer. The intention of this rule is to encourage not discourage, so please use discretion.
- No charge for novice only swimmers entered in max four 25 meter novice events. Regular entry fees apply for novices swimmers entered in any Div 1 50 meter events or a Div 1 swimmer entered in any novice 25 metre events.

MEET PROTOCOL:

- If there is a problem with entries or results at the meet, please follow this procedure: go to your coach, who will then approach the Meet Referee or Meet Manager.

AWARDS:

- Participation ribbons for novices. No points awarded for novice 25 meter events.
- Ribbons for individual and relay events, 1st through 6th place
- Aggregate medals will be awarded for Div.1-8 and Cat "0"swimmers based on highest points earned for first three places.
- Point system will follow BCSSA rules for meets with no consolation finals:: 1st-7 points, 2nd-5pt, 3rd-4pt, 4th-3pt, 5th-2pt, 6th-1pt. These points are doubled for relays.
- Ribbons for new records Div 1-8 and Cat“O” swimmers.

SILENT AUCTION:

- The Nelson Neptune’s will hold a Silent Auction on Saturday. The auction is in the concourse area of the arena.

“FUN” RELAY

- We are scheming away to come up with a super fun relay to be held on Sunday after the last relay while we tabulate the results. Stay tuned for more details.

MISCELLANEOUS:

- The shallow pool will not be available for swimmer use during events.
- Swimmers may use the concourse area during the meet.
- Space for club tents is available beside the parking lot in grassy areas.
- No overnight RV campers or tenting will be allowed in the Recreational Facility parking lot. No parking of RV’s or over length vehicles in the Recreational Facility parking lot. Please park on Lakeside Drive or in the Chako Mika mall parking lot.
- There will be no concession available so please plan accordingly. Nelson has numerous options available nearby. Just up the hill from the NDCC both Vernon St and Baker Street have numerous options. The Chako Mika Mall (go towards the Lake and turn right) has several food court outlets.
- The Nelson City Campground (High Street) will be available for campers. It’s within walking distance of the pool. If you don’t mind driving 20 minutes, camping is also

available at our beautiful Kokanee Provincial Park, located 22 km North of Nelson on Highway 3A.
