Have you ever wanted to spend a summer working and playing in the heart of the beautiful Sea to Sky region? We are pleased to announce that the Squamish Pirates are now accepting applications for Head Coach for the Summer 2025 season.

The Squamish Pirates is a non- profit competitive swim club with approximately 150 swimmers between the ages of 4 and 17 years old. The Club is a member of the Vancouver and District region within the BCSSA.

Our club runs year round with a full time swim coach for both BCSSA and SwimBC. We are looking for a head coach to support the summer portion of our program.

We are looking for a dynamic individual who is dedicated to the sport of swimming and passionate about mentoring young athletes. This person should be driven to help their swimmers reach their potential while fostering a positive, enjoyable, and supportive environment for competitive swimming.

Responsibilities & Expectations of the Coach's role is to:

- Working under our Full Time Head Coach as required to assist with planning, activities, and leadership tasks in April 2025
- Plan, organize, and execute a summer swimming training program for their team/group, including dryland workouts
- Attend BCSSA Coaches Conference (April in Princeton, BC)
- Create detailed practice plans and individualized goals for swimmers and monitor swimmers' progress towards these goals.
- Commit to pre-season planning (April 2025), and all practices and swim meets for the full summer season starting April (pending candidate availability) and ending August 17, 2025.
- Help organize and participate in team social events and bonding activities
- Develop and execute a communication plan that supports swimmers and their families

Qualifications

- Certification to a minimum of Level 1 NCCP or equivalent
- Safe Sport Training module completed through Coaching Association of Canada
- Previous swim coaching experience in a competitive environment and experience as a competitive swimmer.
- National Lifeguard Pool qualification
- Superior leadership, organizational, communication, and team building skills
- A current criminal background check, completed before the season begins

We offer a competitive salary based on qualifications and experience. Housing costs could be offset in addition to salary.
