**Location:** Revelstoke Aquatic Centre, 600 Campbell Ave.

**Facilities:** The Revelstoke Aquatic Centre is an indoor 25 m pool with 6 lanes. Spectator seating is limited. We are pleased to offer our large, indoor air-conditioned multipurpose room for athletes to keep cool between races.

**Concession:** There will be no concession. There are numerous high quality local food vendors 5–10-minute walk from the pool.

**Club Tents:** Tents are allowed outside the pool between the road and the river. Most swimmers will rest between events inside the multi-purpose rooms.

**Format:** The meet will follow a heats and finals format. Heats will take place in the morning session with finals and relays in the afternoon.

## **Entries:**

- Swimmers are allowed to enter four individual events and two relays.
- Parents/guardians may enter their swimmers using the Parent Swim Portal: <a href="https://swimportal.active.com">https://swimportal.active.com</a>. Talk to your club coach for more details.
- Clubs set their own entry deadlines—check with your coach or club rep. Typically, club entry deadlines are 7-10 days before the meet.
- You must register in advance—no deck entries.

## **Entry Fees:**

• A flat fee of \$30 per swimmer will be charged, excluding turtles (FREE).

**Turtles:** All Turtles must be registered with their home club. There will be no charge for Turtle-only swimmers entered into a maximum of four 25 m events. The regular entry fee will apply for turtles entered into any Div 1 events.

- Deadline for sending your club's entry is Tuesday, June 25 at 5pm.
- Please email the Hy-Tek entry file along with the validation text file to the Meet Manager. The Hy-Tek file will be emailed to your club and posted on the BCSSA website by Spring 2024.

## **Rules:**

- All BCSSA rules apply or as the Meet Manager deems fit and fair.
- This meet will be Heats and Finals using an open format. Finals will be seeded by division. Results will be by division.
- Div 8 will swim timed finals in the morning only.
- Consolation finals will be swum for Div 1-4 if there are 3 or more qualifiers.
- Swimmers may enter 4 individual events plus 2 relays.
- Races will be seeded by time within each category on the schedule.
- Best times should be submitted, but only times that swimmers have achieved in sanctioned competition. If no time is available, submit 'no time' (NT). Heats will be seeded according to times submitted.
- Seeding is done by the Hy-tek Meet Manager software. A minimum of changes to seeding will be done at the discretion of the Clerk of Course for efficiency.
- Ocat 1 and Ocat 2 swimmers will swim with their peers in the morning heats.
- No switching of events once a swimmer is entered.

#### Awards:

- Division 1-4: ribbons will be awarded to the top 12 swimmers.
- Division 5-8 and Ocat 1-2: ribbons will be awarded to the top six swimmers.
- Aggregate medals will be awarded for top three girls and boys in each division.
- Team awards will be top overall team.
- Record breaker awards will be given.
- Point scores: 14-12-11-10-9-8-7-5-4-3-2-1 for individual events. Double points will be awarded for relays.

## **Calling of Events:**

- The meet will follow BCSSA policy regarding marshalling calls. The clerk will announce the marshalling of the event two (2) times with two (2) minutes between each announcement.
- All swimmers from Div 1 4 must go to marshaling for each event.
- Swimmers from Div 5 8 need only check in with marshaling once at the beginning of the day. There will be no calling of these events, the swimmers are responsible for ensuring they are behind the blocks and ready to swim when the referee calls the race. Swimmers may still come through the marshalling area to congregate and organize themselves prior to going out on deck. Swimmers will check in with the lane timers to ensure they are in the right heat.

## Officials:

As for all swim meets, we rely heavily on the active volunteerism of parents. Please do your part! New and prospective officials are encouraged to attend the officials meeting. Clubs will be assigned lanes to time throughout the meet.
