

PORT MOODY AQUARIANS' 54th ANNUAL GOLDEN SPIKE INVITATIONAL Saturday and Sunday, June 22-23, 2024

POOL FACILITY

- Westhill Pool in Port Moody 203 Westhill Place (at the end of Glenayre Drive)
- 5-lane, 25-meter competition pool
- Colorado Timing System/HYTEK Meet Manager
- Free parking at Westhill Pool and to the north. Map will be sent prior to the meet.

MEET RULES

- This meet is sanctioned by the BCSSA and all BCSSA rules and amendments will apply. The
 working deck shall consist of those areas within 1.8m of the sides and turning end of the pool
 and within the fenced/covered area at the finished end. Additional areas of the working deck
 shall be cordoned off with temporary barriers. To ensure fairness to all swimmers, the working
 deck will remain off-limits to everyone except swimmers during their events, and officials.
 Spectators are not permitted inside the working deck area. Swimmers can talk to their
 coaches, at the coaches' tables, and then must exit the working deck.
- All swimmers must be registered with BCSSA.
- Swimmers must be entered in their age-appropriate division as per the BCSSA age locator.

MEET FORMAT

- <u>All events are TIMED FINALS</u>; and individual events will be <u>swum as Open Age Group*</u> and separated as follows:
 - » Div 1-3 and OCAT1
 - » Div 4-7, OCAT2 and O8
 - *The 50m/100m Fly events on Saturday will be separated Div 1-4/OCat1 and Div 5-7/OCAT2/O8; and the 50m Fly on Sunday will be Div 5-7/OCAT2/O8
- Results will be separated by division and gender.
- Development 25-meter races for each of the 4 strokes are open to all swimmers DIV 2 and under. These swimmers <u>cannot</u> be entered into the same 50m event in the same stroke.
- Due to time constraints this year, there are **NO TURTLE RACES or PARENT RELAYS**.
- Relays are <u>timed finals and will be swum by Division</u> and take place at the end of the heats each day. Coach relays take place after the Breaststroke events.
- Eliminator 50 FREE (highlighted in blue on the event list page 6): All "S" swimmers born in 2005 or later are eligible. <u>Coaches do not register swimmers for these races.</u>
 - » **ROUND 1** is the 50 Free swims on Saturday for all eligible swimmers.
 - » The fastest FIVE (5) swimmers from Round 1 will face off in the <u>ROUND 2 PRELIMS</u> on <u>Sunday</u> after the DIV 1-3/OCAT1 Backstroke events.

- » The fastest TWO (2) swimmers from Round 2 Prelims will face off in the <u>FINALS</u> which is scheduled immediately following the Coach Relays.
- Marshalling:
 - » DIVISIONS 1-3 and OCAT1 will check in with the Clerk of the Course and be marshalled.
 - » DIVISIONS 4-7, OCAT2 and O8 will self-marshal.

ENTRIES

- Deck entries are permitted <u>BEFORE</u> 7:30am each day.
- Swimmers in Divisions 4-7, OCAT2 and O8 must have completed a 200IM in under 4:00 to be eligible to compete in the 200IM.
- <u>Relay entries:</u> Submit to the Office by 10:00am each morning.
- Submit HYTEK or ACTIVE entries to our Meet Manager at: <u>pma.meetmanager@gmail.com</u> before Tuesday, June 18 at 4:00pm. Any changes to meet entries are due by 11:59pm Wednesday, June 19. <u>Please include a full roster file.</u>
- Maximum of six (6) events per swimmer PLUS two (2) relays. No more than four (4) events per day.
- Heat placements will be available prior to the meet but are subject to change depending on scratches received. Heats may be combined.

MEET START TIME

- Warm up (subject to change):
 - » 7:00 8:00am warm-up times in 30-min blocks. Clubs will be informed of their times closer to the meet.
- Races Start: 8:30am

OFFICIALS

- All clubs are expected to supply deck officials and timers for each day of the meet. Lane timing responsibilities will be emailed to clubs prior to the meet.
- Officials meeting*: 8:00am each day by the dive tank
- Coaches meeting*: 8:10am each day by the dive tank
 * meeting times will depend on warm up times clubs will be informed.

AWARDS

- Individual Events:
 - » Ribbons for 1st to 6th place for all divisions with a minimum of six swimmers.
 - » Ribbons for 1st to 3rd place for all OCAT with a minimum of three swimmers.
- **Relays:** Ribbons for 1st to 3rd place.
- Ribbons will be ready for pick up at the conclusion of Sunday's events. Please ask a <u>representative from your club</u> to collect your club's ribbons from the Office located beside the diving boards.
- Eliminator 50 Free winner and runner-up will receive a Championship award. NO individual points awarded for this event.

- **Train "Whistle" Races** Winners of randomly selected heats throughout the weekend receive a prize.
- **Golden Spike Pins** for swimmers who earn four (4) best times in individual events. Swimmers must have a seed time for each event to be eligible.
- Our Aggregate Award is back! the "Golden Spike". One male and female in each division and in OCAT1 and OCAT2 who earns the most accumulated points in all their individual events (see point chart below) will be awarded the top aggregate award. Points will be calculated from (up to) six (6) individual events. The Golden Spike Aggregate winners will be announced after the completion of the 100 Freestyle events; and swimmers can collect their award towards the end of the Meet.

• No points are awarded for the 25-meter events and the Eliminator 50 Free races.

MEET FEES

- Relays: \$10.00 per relay
- Late entries are subject to a \$10.00 fee
