General Job Description:

- Reports to the Artistic Swimming Head Coach.
- Designs and implements practice plans in conjunction with the Head Coach.
- Meets with swimmers and/or parents to discuss goals and progress.
- Reports progression of swimmers to Head Coach.
- Forwards parent concerns to the Head Coach.
- Works with the coaching team and Director of Artistic Swimming.
- Attends bi-weekly coach meetings and reviews team progress with the Head Coach.
- Works with the Head Coach to determine awards and presents at Awards Night.
- Develops and educates self to become a more effective coach, which will include staying up-to-date with coaching certification, accepting mentorship where possible and participating in clinics and workshops that may be available.
- Attends competitions (local, Regionals and Provincials).
- Participates in Club activities (ie social activities, fundraisers, etc.).
- Acts in accordance with the BCSSA Coaches Code of Ethics.
- Performs other related duties as assigned by the Board.
