Responsibilities & Expectations:

- Plan, organize, and execute a season plan outline and share it with the Head Coach
- Attend the BCSSA Coaches Conference unless excused by the Head Coach.
- Create detailed practice plans and individualized goals for swimmers and monitor swimmers' progress towards these goals.
- Commit to pre-season planning, and all practices and all swim meets for the full summer season starting May 1, 2025, and ending August 4th, 2025.

Qualifications

- Certification to a minimum of Level 1 NCCP or equivalent (PoCo Marlins will support you in obtaining your NCCP certification but you must commit to obtaining it by May 1, 2025)
- Previous swim coaching experience in a competitive environment and experience as a competitive swimmer
- WSI or other swim teaching qualification is preferred for Novice Coaches
- National Lifeguard Pool qualification
- Superior leadership, organizational, communication, and team-building skills
- A current criminal background check, completed before the season begins
