General Job Description:

- Report to the Head Coach and Assistant Head Coach
- Design training sessions to improve swimmers' technique and endurance. Ensure the safety of all swimmers during practices and meets.
- Motivate swimmers, helping them set personal goals and pushing them to improve. Provide emotional and mental support to keep swimmers focused and confident. Organize and manage swimmers' participation in competitions, helping to select events and relay teams.
- Maintain open lines of communication with parents, providing updates on progress, upcoming events, and any concerns or needs.
- Help foster a sense of teamwork, encouraging collaboration and camaraderie among swimmers.
- Track swimmers' progress over time through best times, performance analysis, and feedback.
- Maintain up-to-date coaching certifications and act in accordance with the BCSSA Coaches Code of Ethics.
