



The **Kokanee Summer Swim Club** is currently accepting applications for two **Assistant Coaches** for the 2024 Summer Swim Season. You will become part of a dynamic team that works together to support our swimmers to develop their skills, compete in local, Regional, and Provincial swim meets, make new friends and have fun!

The Kokanee Swim Club had it's largest participant season in 2023, and we are anticipating 2024 to be similar with approximately 65 swimmers of all ages (3-17yrs), experience & skill levels.

Our facility is an outdoor 5 lane, 25 yard pool in Princeton, BC. The pool area is surrounded by a maintained grassy area, which allows for warm-up and dryland training.

This individual will have:

- Strong leadership qualities and will foster a fun and safe environment for our swimming athletes to develop their skills
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships and to communicate effectively with a wide variety of people.
- Effective oral and written communications skills that can be adapted to suit a wide range of swimmers ages.

Job Description:

- The Assistant Coach will work under supervision of the Head Coach, to continue to grow and develop our program.
- The summer swim season will run from beginning of May to mid August. (Including the BC Provincial Swim Meet)
- Hours will be approximately 40 hours a week, including events and weekend swim meets
- The number of swim meets attended will be between six to eight, dependent on swimmer registration numbers and coaches hired.
- Pool times will have both early morning and afternoon hours
- Follow the BCSSA rules and applicable code of ethics and coaching standards
- Be prepared for each practice session by collaborating with the Head Coach on developing practice plans that are appropriate for each age group that is assigned to you.
- Work with swimmers to discuss progress to achieve their goals
- Work with Volunteer Coaches
- Attend swim meets that are applicable to the season.
- Promote Team Spirit & assist and support all team-related activities.

Qualifications:

- Bronze Cross

- Valid NLS (preference)
- CPR level C and AED certification.
- Preference will be given to NCCP 101 and previous coaching experience
- Experience as a competitive swimmer
- Criminal Record background check completed (for applicants 19 years of age and older)

If the applicant resides out of town, the swim club will help find accommodation/housing.
