Facility	Centennial Pool 3050 Chester Street (corner of Shaughnessy St. & Lougheed Hwy in Aggie Park). Port Coquitlam, BC	
Dates	Saturday, June 1th to Sunday, June 2th, 2024

Eligibility	Open to all registered BCSSA members for the current season.	
	Swimmers may enter up to 5 individual events and 2 relay events.	
	Divisions determined by the Age locater provided by BCSSA.	
Format	Each day(Saturday and Sunday) is separated into two sessions:	
	The morning session is reserved for divisions 4 to 8 and O-cat 2. It is expected to begin at 8:00am and run until approximately 10:30 - 11:30 am .	
	The afternoon session is reserved for divisions 1 to 3 and O-Cat 1, including 6 and under. Heats are expected to begin at 12:30pm - 1:00pm and run until approximately 5:00pm .	
	All events are timed finals.	
Individual Races	Individual races will feature circle-seeded open divisions separated by gender (for example, Girls Div 4-8 seeded together, Boys Div 4-8 seeded together).	
Relay Races	 Relay slips for each day must be presented to the Clerk of Course by 9:30 AM and entries must be on the Official Relay Entry Form or reasonable facsimile Girls and boys relays for divisions 1 to 6 must have four "S" swimmers. Girls and boys relays for divisions 7 and 8 may have any combination of "S" and "O" swimmers. O Cat 1 and O Cat 2 relays must have a minimum of one "O" swimmers. 	
Development Races	25 meter freestyle and backstroke development events are open to all members in division 1. Swimmers cannot swim both 25m and 50m events of the same stroke.	
Family Relay	Saturday at the start of the second session we will be having a 100 meter family relay. One or two families can enter swimmers to race against other families. No age limits, buoyancy aids are allowed. Each swimmer is expected to complete 25m - diving only permissible on the deep end of the pool. Teams may be	

	deck entered, but we prefer if clubs enter their A, B, C etc relays beforehand. Ribbons may or may not be awarded, but there should be some amazing pictures and videos. Parents will need to fill out a parent relay membership or some other BCSSA membership (\$5 charge for temporary membership with accompanying insurance coverage).	
Warm Ups	Morning session warms-ups run from 6:45am to 7:30am . Afternoon Session warm-ups run from 11:00am to 12:00pm. on Day 1 and 11:30am to 12:30pm. on Day 2	
	Lane assignments will be emailed to the participating clubs ahead of the meet.	
Officials	All clubs are expected to supply senior deck officials as well as junior/intermediate stroke and turn officials during the meet. Signups for these positions will be made available near the Announcer's desk.	
	There will be two officials meeting per day . For officials working in the morning session, the meeting will take place at 7:00am near the announcer's desk. For officials working in the afternoon session, there will be a meeting at 11:30am.on Day 1 and 12:00pm on Day 2 Attendance is mandatory. We ask that if you are available to officiate for both the morning and afternoon session that you choose the afternoon session (or both).	
Coaches	 Coaches must be on deck for warm up Times and lanes for warm ups will be assigned after official entries are received. They will be emailed out a couple of days before the meet. At the meet they'll be on the announcers table board at the north end of the pool. Coaches Meeting will be held at 7:15am 	
Rules	The latest BCSSA Rules and Regulations are in effect and will be strictly enforced with the exception of the 25 meter development events.	
Timing System	Colorado Electronic Timing System with electronic touch pad and buttons interfaced with the Hy-Tek Meet Manager and a six line display scoreboard will be used as the approved automatic judging and timing system in accordance with the BCSSA rules.	
Awards/Prizes	For individual races, divisions 1 to 7 swimmers will receive 1st to 6th place ribbons.	
	Total Aggregate points will be calculated and Gold and Silver will be awarded to the top 3 finishers up to 5 individual events will count towards total aggregate points. Gold, Silver and Bronze medals to the top three aggregate point totals in each division.	
	Prizes will be awarded for swimmers during "bell races".	
Marshaling	There will be marshaling for the afternoon session (divisions 1-3 and O Cat 1) on both days.	

	There will be no marshaling for the morning session (divisio 4-8 and O Cat 2) on both days.	
	Courtesy marshaling calls will be made by the announcer.	
Results	Results will be posted on a wall, in Meet Mobile and emailed to attending club representatives	
Volunteers	Each participating club is required to provide at least three timers and officials for each shift. Smaller clubs (18 entries or less) may be delegated shared responsibilities. Refreshments will be provided for all volunteers, officials and coaches. Dietary restrictions will not be accommodated. Everyone is encouraged to bring water bottles to reduce waste.

Pool	6 lanes, 25 meter outdoor pool(short course competition).		
Viewing	Spectators will only be able to view from the designated spectator viewing areas Spectators\Parents are also not permitted on the working pool deck and in the marshaling area.		
Tenting	Tenting will be available in Aggie Park Ample tent space available for daily use but there is no security for leaving tents overnight. Refer to the map on the last page.		
Cooking	Cooking is permitted as per municipal regulations at the time of the event		
Change Rooms	Available in the facility. There will also be porta-potties available outside the fenced in pool deck.		
Food	There is deck food and an excellent (PoCo Marlin staffed) concession stand at this event. Cooking is allowed in the park as per City of Port Coquitlam guidelines - assuming no fire restrictions at the time of the meet.		
Parking	 Parking is adequate but important restrictions apply DO NOT PARK IN FRONT OF ANY BUSINESSES IN THE AGGIE PARK AREA DO NOT PARK IN THE ALLEY BEHIND POOL THIS IS A FIRE LANE PARKING IN THESE AREAS MAY RESULT IN YOUR VEHICLE BEING TOWED THERE IS A LARGE PARKING LOT ACROSS THE HIGHWAY please obey the municipal parking guidelines and any spaces reserved for pool staff and meet officials.

Events	Swimmers may enter a maximum of 5 individual races and 2 relays (one per day)	
	Swimmers in Div 1 may enter either the 25 meter or the 50 meter events but not both distances of the same stroke.	
Submission	 A complete meet entry package must be sent to the Meet Registrar (dal@burnabymantas.ca) on or before May 27, 2024 and shall include the following: An Exported meet entry file, roster file from Hy-Tek Team Manager. Swimmers' best times must be current as of May 1, 2024 and must be entered. A cheque made payable to Burnaby Mountain Mantas Swim Club. Contact information (phone number and email address) for your club's Director of Officials, meet entry person and the results/awards contact person. 	
Deadline	Entry package must be in on or before May 27, 2024 for inclusion in the heat sheets and programs.	
Swimmers	All swimmers must be registered with BCSSA.	
	Swimmers must be entered in their age-appropriate division as the BCSSA age locator. Swimmers will not be allowed to "swim up" in higher divisions or "swim down" in lower divisions for their individual events.	
Deck Entries	Deck entries will not be accepted on the day of the swim meet.	
Scratches	All scratches prior to the meet must be submitted by 7:00 am for divisions 4 to 8 races and 11:30 pm for divisions 1 to 3 races on the day of the event. There will be no refunds on scratches.	
	Scratches on the day of the meet must be made to the Clerk of the Course as soon as possible.	
Confirmation	The Meet Registrar will confirm entries via email to all clubs upon receipt of entries. If a club does not receive a confirmatory email, it means the entries have not been received. Please contact the Meet Registrar if this is the case.
