### **Format:**

- Timed Finals finals - Div 1-8 and O cat.
- All BCSSA 2024 rules apply or as the Meet Manager deems fit & fair.
- Events will be combined where possible to keep the lanes filled
- Swimmers with NT will be seeded in the slower heats
- All turtle events and relay events will be timed finals
- All “O” category swimmers will swim with their respective “S” division.
- Relays will be swum at the end of each day

### **Marshalling:**

We will be using a “Simplified Marshalling Procedure”, Divisions 5-8 will NOT be marshalled, but swimmers must check in once at Marshalling at the start of each day. These swimmers are responsible for being behind the blocks and ready to swim when the referee calls the race. There will be no announcing of events for divisions 5-8. The heat sheets will be posted to allow swimmers to verify their event, heat and lane assignments. Swimmers may still come through the marshalling area to congregate and organize themselves prior to going out on deck. Swimmers will check in with the lane timers to ensure they are in the right heat.

Marshalling for Divisions 1-4:

Calling of the meet will follow the BCSSA policy regarding marshalling calls. Events will be called 2 times with 2 minutes between each announcement. Div 1-4 must go to marshalling for each event. For all div 4 events except for the 50m fly, the div 4 swimmer will be alone in marshalling. They can take this opportunity to see how div 5-8 marshal themselves and will have guidance from Marshals to ensure they arrive at their event on time.

### **Entries:**

- Entry Deadline is **Tuesday, June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at 8pm**. All entries received past the deadline will be considered late entries and charged a late fee of \$10 per event.
- Late entries will be accepted up until Thursday, June 6<sup>th</sup> evening at 7 p.m.
- Parents/guardians may enter their swimmers using the Parent Swim Portal: <https://swimportal.active.com>

- No Deck entries – no exceptions.
- Swimmers can enter up to 6 individual events and 2 relays.
- Relay entries must be submitted to clerk of the course **prior to 10am** each day.

**Coaches: please carefully check the confirmation sheets that are sent back to you after you submit your entries. Any errors must be sent back to Kevin Bushell prior to Thursday, June 6, 2024**

**Entry Fees:** A flat fee of \$30.00 per swimmer will be charged, excluding turtles who swim for free. There will be no refunds for scratched swimmers. Payment in full is expected by Noon on Sunday to the Meet Manager. Cheques payable to **Salmon Arm Sockeyes Swim Club**

**Scratches:** By 8pm Friday at the pool for Saturday events & following the conclusion of the last event on Saturday for Sunday events.

**Turtles:** All turtles must be registered with their home club, enter with team entries. No charge for 25m turtle events, regular fees will apply for turtles entered in Div1 events, 50m or 100m races. Any turtle 7yrs old or older can only register in Turtle events or events in their appropriate division, not a combination of both. Turtle races to be held mid-morning on Saturday and Sunday. All turtle swimmers will do a water start (no diving). A senior swimmer or coach may accompany turtle swimmers. Turtles will receive goody bags.

**Timers and Officials:** All clubs are expected to have individuals to work as deck officials. Clubs will be assigned lanes to time/record throughout the meet. Please organize volunteers from your club to fill these positions. Volunteers will be fed delicious snacks through out the weekend.

For all officials, and those interested in becoming an official, there will be a Stoke & Turn Clinic offered on the Saturday at lunch. This is a great way to build our group of regional officials - many hands make light work! Lunch will be provided.
