

LOCATION:

Winskill Aquatic and Fitness Centre

5575 9th Avenue Tsawwassen, BC

- This is a 25m, 6-lane indoor pool.
- Ample space for tents during the meet (no overnight storage)
- There is limited indoor seating. Please free up seats once your swimmer has completed their race.

PARKING:

There is NO PARKING AVAILABLE at the turf fields north of the pool. Parking is **very limited** near the pool, as this is a busy mixed-use complex.

**DO NOT park anywhere you see yellow lines or traffic cones...
your car WILL be towed**

Instead, we have access to the parking lot at **South Delta Secondary** for overflow parking, which is a short walk to the pool (we promise!)

CONCESSION:

There are several food and beverage options at our meet:

- the **Tsawwassen Lions Club** will have their food truck on site both days, providing breakfast and lunch.
- A candy & treats concession will be available, in addition to various shops and restaurants within walking distance

MEET INFO:

All events are timed finals.

This is an official BCSSA swim meet. Swimmers competing at this meet are eligible to swim at Regionals



SEEDING EVENTS:

- All swims will be seeded by entry time. We are running separate events for Junior swimmers (Div 1-3 & O1) and Senior swimmers (Div 4-7) & O2-O8).
- Junior events (Div 1-3 for "S" swimmers) separated into A/B results.
- Entries with "NT" for a time will not be accepted. Please provide an approximate (reasonably accurate) time for your swimmers so they can be seeded properly.

RELAY EVENTS:

- Relays will be fun events!
- Teams may be co-ed, and may include any four members of your club, regardless of age.
- Your relay entries **MUST** have a seed time. Entries with "**NT**" for a time will **not** be accepted.
- Please provide names of swimmers on relay teams to the Clerk of the Course no later than **10:00 am** each day
- Ribbons will not be awarded for relays. There will be special prizes for the relay races. Stay tuned for communication on this closer to race day.

MAXIMUM EVENTS:

• Swimmers may enter a maximum of 5 individual events and 2 relays

DEVELOPMENTAL EVENTS:

- Events for developmental swimmers will be offered as 25m for freestyle, breaststroke, and backstroke.
- Coaches are asked to enter developmental swimmers (up to Div3 permitted) into these 25m events.
- Athletes who swim a 25m event **may not** compete in the 50m or 100m event in that same stroke.
- Swimmers in the 25m events are not eligible for disqualification.
- Swimmers will receive participation ribbons in the 25m events, and there will be no points awarded in the developmental races.



SCRATCHES:

• Prior to meet scratches can be emailed to

• <u>Day of meet:</u> scratches must be handed in, on the form provided, to the Clerk of the Course no later than 7:30 am SHARP.

No refunds for scratches made after the June 6 deadline

DECK ENTRIES:

There will be NO DECK ENTRIES allowed for this event. **NO EXCEPTIONS**

RULES:

• BCSSA rules for 2024 apply at this meet, or as the Meet Manager sees fit or fair.

SCORING:

- Place points for individual events ("A" tier only) will be as follows:
 - 1. 7 pts
 - 2. 5 pts
 - 3. 4 pts
 - 4. 3 pts
 - 5. 2 pts
 - 6. 1 pt

AWARDS:

Individual Awards

- 25m participant participation ribbon
- Tier "A" Individual "S" 1st-6th place ribbons for Div 1-7
- Tier "B" Individual "S" 1st-6th place ribbons for Div1-3
- Ocat1, Ocat2 & Ocat8 1st-6th place ribbons.

Relay Awards

• Medley and Free relays Fun events. No ribbons will be awarded.





OFFICIALS:

- Each club will be expected to supply timers, recorders, and deck officials.
- A sign-up schedule will be provided in the week leading up to the meeting.
- Snacks and drinks will be provided for officials and volunteers on deck.

SCHEDULE

- A warm-up schedule will be created and sent out to participating clubs after the entry deadline prior to the meet.
- Warm –up generally start at 7:15 am and run to 8:45 am
- Officials meeting takes place at 8:30 am Saturday and Sunday
- Coaches meeting takes place at 8:45am Saturday and Sunday

FEES:

•Individual events: \$9 per event

• Relays: \$15 per team

• Developmental events: no charge





Parking

 Parking in front of the facility is LIMITED. We recommend parking at South Delta Secondary School at the corner 8a Ave and 53a Street.



- As you leave the pool parking turn right on 55a Street (first right)
- At the stop sign at 8a Ave, turn right
- Travel along 8a Ave and just past the tennis courts on the left is the entrance to the parking lot. Look for a poster that says Welcome to the B4 Meet
- Follow the YELLOW DOTS on the map to the "sneaky path" back to the pool. The path is built by Delta & public use is fully permitted. It's a short walk
