Steps for Registration:

1. Submit this application to the appropriate Regional Board for Regional approval.
2. If approved by the Regional Board, the Regional Director shall submit the application to the Provincial Board of Directors for final approval. All applications must be submitted to the BCSSA before January 15th.
3. If approved, the club must pay the club affiliation fee on or before April 1st to the Regional Registrar.
4. The club must incorporate as a Society in British Columbia and be in good standing as per the requirements of the Society Act prior to April 1st of the year the group wishes to join the BCSSA.

A club may appeal any decision by the Regional Executive or the Provincial Board to the Appeals Committee of BCSSA.
