Format	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Timed Finals – Open format</li> <li>- BCSSA 2024 rules apply or as Meet Manager deems fit and fair</li> <li>- Swimmers with NT will be seeded in the slower heats</li> <li>- Turtle events are final and not timed</li> <li>- Relays will be timed finals in the afternoons only</li> <li>- Swimmers may enter 6 individual events and 2 relays</li> <li>- “O” Cat will swim with their peers</li> <li>- Electrically timed event</li> </ul>
Marshalling	<p>We will be using the “Simplified Marshalling procedure”. Division 5-8 will NOT be marshalled, but swimmers must check in once Marshalling at the start of the day. These swimmers are responsible for being behind the blocks ready to swim when the referee calls the race. There will be no announcing of events for Divs 5-8. The Heat Sheets will be posted to allow swimmers to verify their event, heat and lane assignment.</p> <p>Swimmers may come through the Marshalling area to congregate and organise themselves prior to going on deck. Swimmers will check in with the lane timer to ensure they are in the right heat.</p> <p>Marshalling Div 1-4:  Calling of the meet will follow the BCSSA policy regarding marshalling calls. Events will be called 2 times with 2 minutes between each announcement. Div 1-4 must go to marshalling for each event. For all Div 4 events except 50 Fly, the Div 4 swimmers will be alone in Marshalling. They can take this opportunity to see how Div 5-8 marshal themselves and will have guidance from Marshals to ensure they arrive at their event on time.</p>
Officials:	All Clubs are asked to supply deck officials, timers, recorders, place judged and other positions as needed. Deck food is provided. Please bring refillable water bottles. Clubs will be assigned lanes for times and recorders throughout the meet. We thank you already for your assistance, our meet couldn't be as wonderful as it is without your support.

Fees	Flat fee of \$30 per swimmer. Turtle swimmers in the 25m races events only are not required to pay. Payment in full is expected by noon on Sunday to the Meet Manager. Cheques payable to: Lumby Lightning Swim Club.
Entries:	Must be received by e-mail to <a href="mailto:ok.director@bcsummerswimming.com">ok.director@bcsummerswimming.com</a> no later than Tuesday June 18 <sup>th</sup> , 2024 at 4pm PST  No deck entries will be allowed. Swimmers event registration will be via Active Network Swim Portal
Relays	All relay entries must be submitted to the meet office prior to 10 am each day
Scatches	By 8pm Friday for events Saturday & following relays on Saturday for Sunday events
Turtles	All Turtles must be registered with their home club. Please enter with team entries, Turtles can enter 25m events for free. The regular fees will apply for turtle swimmers that enter any 50m or 100m events. Swimmers entering 25m events cannot swim a longer distance in the same stroke. Turtle swimmers will do a water start (no diving). A senior swimmer or coach may accompany turtle swimmers.
