Head Coach Duties:

The Head Coach role is a full-time position and oversees hiring, managing, and mentoring coaching staff, designing and implementing seasonal swim programs, and ensuring smooth team operations with support from the Coaching Committee and Board. The focus is on creating a fun, supportive environment while encouraging excellence amongst swimmers.

- Manage and direct coaching staff, including hiring, evaluation, discipline, and termination.
- Oversee practice plans, swimmer assessment, safety, and resource use.
- Responsible for all activities, staff, and swimmer conduct..
- Foster teamwork and mentor coaches, ensuring adherence to ethical standards.
- Conduct regular staff meetings, performance reviews, and parent communications.
- Maintain professional communication with staff, swimmers, parents, and the Board.
- Oversee registration, enforce team policies, manage pool usage, and support strategic planning.
- Schedule staff, practices, meets, and events, ensuring clear communication with all stakeholders.
- Foster positive team attitudes, sportsmanship, and technical development.
- Supervise safety, swimmer supervision, and equipment use.
- Lead swimmer recognition programs and oversee meet preparations.
- Ensure coaching presence and swimmer preparation for all meets, including Regional and Provincial competitions.



- Handle meet entries, awards criteria, and meet attendance.
- Lifeguard when needed.
- Manage swimmer information on Hytek and Active.
- Perform other related duties as assigned by the Board.
