All coaches will report directly to the Vikings Head Coach.

### **Responsibilities and Expectations for the Role:**

- Plan, organize and execute a winter maintenance swimming training program for your team/group;
- As part of a larger coaching team, be a role model in demonstrating and fostering a positive team environment;
- Create detailed, individualized goals for swimmers and monitor swimmers' progress towards those goals;
- Commitment to all practices early September 2024 to late April 2025. (There are no practices held on regular school holidays such as Spring Break etc.), and
- Develop and execute a communication plan that supports swimmers & their families;

### **Qualifications:**

- Certification to a minimum of Level 1 NCCP or equivalent
- Previous swim coaching experience in a competitive environment and experience as a competitive swimmer
- Superior leadership, organizational, communication and team building skills
- A current criminal background check, completed before the season begins.
