GENERAL CRITERIA

Scholarships will be awarded to applicants who best combine the qualifications set forth hereunder. The selection committee will determine the number of scholarships and the amount given each year.

ELIGIBILITY

All scholarship candidates must be in their graduating year of high school or have already graduated from high school at the time of application.

QUALIFICATIONS

-Present or former member of Simon Fraser Region (BCSSA)

-C+ average or better in the candidates last year of high school (in order to equalize all candidates, regardless of their current academic status

-Community involvement – community is not necessarily restricted to the aquatic community, and diversity of involvement is looked upon very favourably. Activities that are interpreted as being part of a 'job-track' are weighted to a lesser degree. Letters of support are encouraged.

SELECTION

Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee comprised of a designate of the Parish family, a Simon Fraser Regional representative and one other.

SCHOLARSHIP AVAILABILITY

The scholarship will be made available to the successful applicant after proof of registration at a registered, post-secondary, institution of their choice. All cheques will be payable to the successful applicant. The scholarship winner may defer receipt of their award for a period of no longer than one academic year, after which the scholarship would be forfeited. Deferment requests must be submitted in writing, and include an explanation. Deferment requests are forwarded to the Simon Fraser Regional Director at: sf.director@bcsummerswimming.com

DATE AND PLACE OF SUBMISSION

Applications, supporting letters and other documentation must be received no later than July 1st of the current year. There shall be no exceptions. All documents must be submitted in .pdf/ Word/ .jpg format.
