The **2024 POCO MARLINS DEVELOPMENT MEET** will have the 6 & Under and Div. 1 events combined for the heats, but results will be separated. This is the same for the Div. 2/3/4 events. All events will be timed finals.

The **2024 POCO MARLINS INVITATIONAL MEET** will have prelims and finals in each individual event, except for Cat. O and Div. 8, which will be timed finals. There will also be consolation finals for division 1-3 50m events. For prelims, divisions 1-3 and 4-7 will be combined by seeding time (1-4 and 5-7 for 50 fly). Results and finals will be separated into each division.

Returning this year is the **Dash for Cash**, sponsored by **Intercity Appraisals**. It's a second 50 free event, with prelims on Sunday morning and finals on Sunday afternoon. It will be restricted to the fastest 18 boys and girls entered, based on valid seed times, and the top 6 will swim the final with **Cash Prizes** for the top three girls and boys. The event is restricted to 'S' swimmers only, Divs 1-7, and swimmers must swim in at least one other event on both Saturday and Sunday. The Dash for Cash does not count towards the 5 individual events as it is a special race.

Back by popular demand this year we will have bongo races throughout the weekend sponsored by Livian Smith, Mortgage Broker with Dominion Lending Centres. Athletes will have an opportunity throughout the weekend to win Cash Prizes. When the bongo rings the winner of that heat will win a cash prize: Relays and finals will not have bell events.

This meet is sanctioned by the BCSSA and all BCSSA rules will apply. The working deck shall consist of those areas within 1.8m of the sides and turning end of the pool and within the fenced/covered area at the finished end. Additional areas of the working deck shall be cordoned off with temporary barriers To ensure fairness to all swimmers, the working deck will remain off-limits to everyone except swimmers during their events, and officials. Spectators are not permitted inside the working deck area. Swimmers can talk to their coaches, at the coaches' tables, and then must exit the working deck.

PoCo Marlins INVITATIONAL SWIM MEET FACILITIES

- 6 lane, 25 metre outdoor pool.
- Concession stand available all three days.
- Ample tent space is available for daily use but no security for leaving tents overnight.

PARKING

- Parking is adequate but the following important restrictions apply:
 - **DO NOT PARK IN FRONT OF ANY BUSINESSES IN THE AREA**
 - □ DO NOT PARK IN THE ALLEY BEHIND POOL THIS IS A FIRE LANE.
 - □ PARKING IN THESE AREAS MAY RESULT IN YOUR VEHICLE BEING TOWED.
 - □ There is plenty of parking in the Safeway lot and a pedestrian overpass to access it.

COACHES

- Coaches must be on deck for warm-up.
- Times and lanes for warm-ups will be assigned after official entries are received. They will be emailed a couple of days before the meet. At the meet they will be on the announcers table board at the north end of the pool.

OFFICIALS

- Each club will be required to supply senior deck officials, timers, and recorders.
- Please reach out to our Meet Ref Steve MacGregor to notify him of available senior deck officials. There will be a sign-up form sent out the week of the meet and posted for reference at the announcer's table. officials@pocomarlins.com

Please include the name and phone number of the meet entry person for your club. Revisions will be accepted until June 12th at 6:00 pm.

- Swimmers may enter FIVE individual events and TWO relay events.

PoCo Marlins INVITATIONAL SWIM MEET SEEDING

- Each competitor must be registered with BCSSA.
- Swimmers will be seeded per BCSSA Rules.
- There will be **NO DECK ENTRIES** permitted at this meet.
- **FINALS** will be the fastest six swimmers in each event and **CONSOLATION FINALS** will be the 7th to 12th fastest swimmers in Divisions 1, 2, and 3 50m events only based on results achieved during each day's preliminary heats.
- Any events/heats with fewer than 5 swimmers may be combined for efficiency.
- Relays, Division 8, Category O1 and O2, and Development events are swum as timed finals during the heats.

RELAYS

- Relay slips for each day must be presented to the Clerk of Course by 9:30 AM and entries must be on the Official Relay Entry Form or reasonable facsimile.
- There are no relay events for Divisions 4 through 7, but we encourage coaches to combine senior swimmers from these divisions on Div 8 relays.

SCRATCHES

• Any scratches after June 11, 2024, are to be submitted to the Clerk of the Course by 7:15 AM on the day of the meet. **NO REFUNDS ON LATE SCRATCHES**.

CLERK OF THE COURSE AND MARSHALING

- The Clerk of the Course and Marshals will be available throughout the meet.
- DURING PRELIMS swimmers of senior events will NOT be required to check in with the Clerk of the Course and will be assumed to be competing UNLESS scratched before the start of the meet each day.
- The Meet Manager shall post current heat sheets in a conspicuous location to allow swimmers to verify their event, heat, and lane assignments.
- Div 4-8 and CAT 2 will not require marshaling during prelims.
- During FINALS, the Clerk of the Course shall call the swimmer's event 2 times with at least 1 minute between each call. If a swimmer is not present at the clerk of course at this time, they will be disqualified.
- It is the responsibility of the swimmer or alternate to be at the Clerk of the Course when the final event is called.

RESULTS

• Results will be posted on our website and emailed to the same club representatives that submit entries. We will send both the HYTEK zipfile and the complete results in HTML.
