#### Eligibility:

- All participating swimmers must be registered with BCSSA for the 2024 season.
- All swimmers must be able to swim unassisted.
- Swimmers participating in the Development Meet are not eligible to attend this meet.
- Swimmers may enter six (6) individual events and two (2) relay events.

#### **Entries:**

Electronic entries must be received by email <a href="mailto:computers@coquitlamsharks.org">coquitlamsharks.org</a> by 5:00pm Monday July 15, 2024 and include:

- Meet entries (Hy-tek format) and full Club Roster (Hy-tek format).
- Name, email, phone number of the Club's computer/meet entry person.
- Name, email, phone number of the Club's Director of officials/parent volunteer coordinator.
- No deck entries will be accepted.
- The meet is capped at 650 swimmers.

#### Fees:

- Individual Events: \$7.50 per individual event.
- Relay Events: \$10.00 per relay team.
- The President or Vice President must receive cheques payable to "Coquitlam Sharks" in person by **Sunday**, **July 21**, **2024**.

<sup>\*\*</sup>Finals Warm-up will be approximately 20 minutes after the completion of the last events in the Preliminary Heats.

#### Facilities:

- 25 metre, 8 lane pool.
- Dive tank will be for warm-up & cool down. The dive tank is not available during pre-event warm up. Swimmers must be supervised by a coach from their club at all times.
- Concession is open both days. Across the street from the pool, Eagle Ridge Plaza has an assortment of restaurant options.
- No smoking or open fires are permitted.

#### Parking:

- Parking at Eagle Ridge Pool is reserved for disabled attendees with parking passes clearly displayed. There is **no slow down/drop** off on Lansdowne Drive or in the Eagle Ridge Pool Lot.
- Parking is available at Scott Creek Middle School and Gleneagle Secondary School.
   Please note there is NO parking at Eagle Ridge Plaza Shopping Mall or on Lansdowne
   Drive in an undesignated area. City Bylaw officers will be patrolling parking lots and the surrounding streets.
- Refer to attached map for parking lot locations.

#### Tenting:

- Day tenting is allowed in the parking lot at Eagle Ridge Pool. Clubs will be allocated a specific area once entries are received.
- Club canopies may be set up in the parking lot at Eagle Ridge Pool on Friday July 19th between a specific timeframe to be confirmed closer to the meet.
- Club canopies may be left overnight in the assigned area of the parking lot only.
   Overnight security will be on site, but all items will be left at the owner's risk

#### Viewing:

- Unless volunteering, parents are required to stay behind the fencing on deck.
- Spectator viewing and bleachers are located on the pool deck in designated areas.

#### Officials:

 All clubs must supply senior deck officials and junior/intermediate officials for stroke and turn during the meet. Timing and recording lanes will be assigned to clubs, which they are responsible for filling. Postings of positions will be located in the concrete circle next to the announcer's table on the North side of the pool.

#### Meet Format: Combined Meet with Heats and Finals:

- All current BCSSA rules and regulations apply.
- Preliminary Heats:
  - o Individual events Div 1 to 7 will swim preliminary combined heats in combined divisions (Div 1 to 3 and O-Cat 1 and Div 4 to 7)
  - o O-Cat 1 & O-Cat 2/O-Cat 8 will be swum as timed finals
  - o All relays are timed finals
- Finals:
  - o Divisions 1 to 7 will be swum as individual finals
- Relays:
  - o Div 1 7 Relays must have four "S" swimmers.

- An "S" swimmer may be entered in an O-Cat relay. Div 1-3 with O-Cat 1 and Div 4-7 in O-Cat 2, as long as there is a minimum of one O-Cat swimmer entered in the relay team.
- Heats or events may be combined, changed, cancelled during the meet at the discretion of the Meet Manager.

#### Marshalling:

- Marshalling area is located outside of the pool entrance gate in the parking lot. Access to this area is for athletes, coaches and officials only.
- Preliminary Heats: Divisions 1-3 will be marshalled. Divisions 4 through 8 will NOT be
  marshalled and will be assumed to be competing unless scratched before the start of the
  meet each day. Events highlighted in yellow on the event list below will not require
  marshaling during preliminaries.
- Finals: All Divisions will be marshalled.
- Other Marshalling Information:
  - o The Clerk of the Course shall call the swimmers event 2 times with 2 minutes between each call. If a swimmer is not present at the clerk of course at this time, they will be disgualified.
  - o It is the responsibility of the swimmer or alternate to be at the Clerk of the Course when their event is called.
- Heat sheets will be posted in the marshalling and results areas.

#### **Timing System:**

- Colorado® timing system with electronic touch pad and plungers interfaced with Hy-Tek
  Meet Manager® and an 8-line display scoreboard will be used as the approved automatic
  judging and timing system in accordance with BCSSA rules.
- If a malfunction or light touch invalidates the touchpad results, the electronic plunger results will be considered Official Times.

#### Prizes:

- Bell Races: Random Bell Races will occur during the meet. Winners of the races will win a prize.
- Prizes will be available at the volunteer check-in tent across from the concession.

#### Awards:

- Individual Events: Div 1 to 4 receive 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> place ribbons, Div 5 to 8 and O-Cat 1&2 receive 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> place ribbons.
- Relay Events: All divisions and categories receive 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> place ribbons.

#### Points:

Individual points are awarded as follows: 1st place 20 pts, 2nd place 17 pts, 3rd place 16 pts, 4th place 15 pts, 5th place 14 pts, 6th place 13 pts, 7th place 12 pts and 8th place 11 pts.


